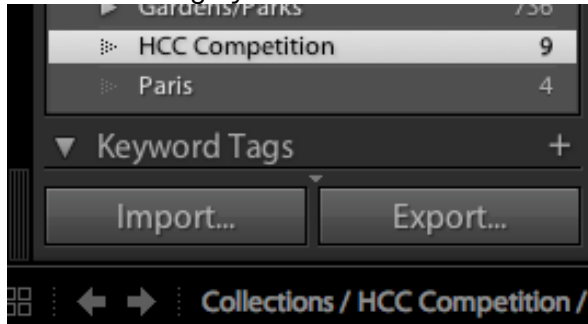


How To Resize Images in Adobe Lightroom

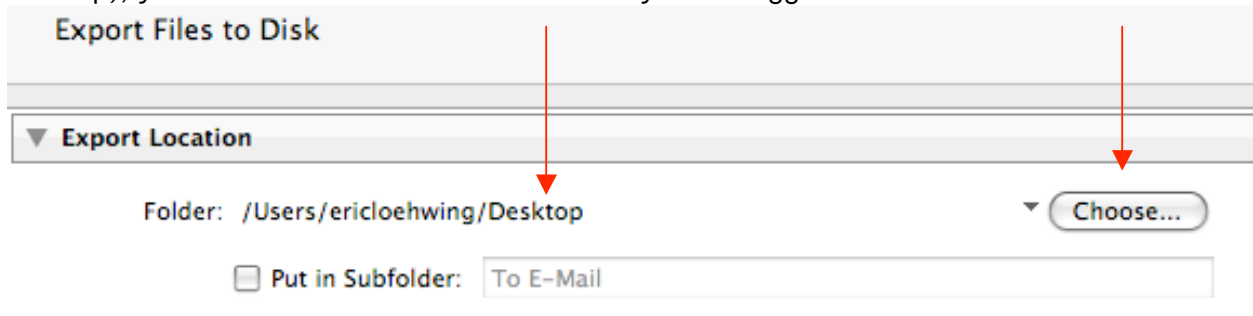
Step One

Select the image you want to resize in the Library Mode. Then click on Export.



Step Two

Click on the Choose button to establish where you are exporting your image to (probably your desktop); you'll then retrieve it from there when you are logged into the HCC website.



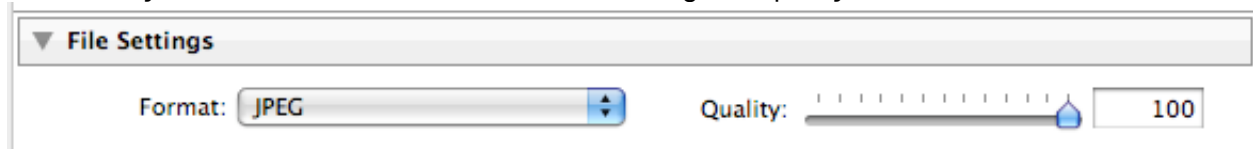
Step Three

Name your file using the drop-down menu:



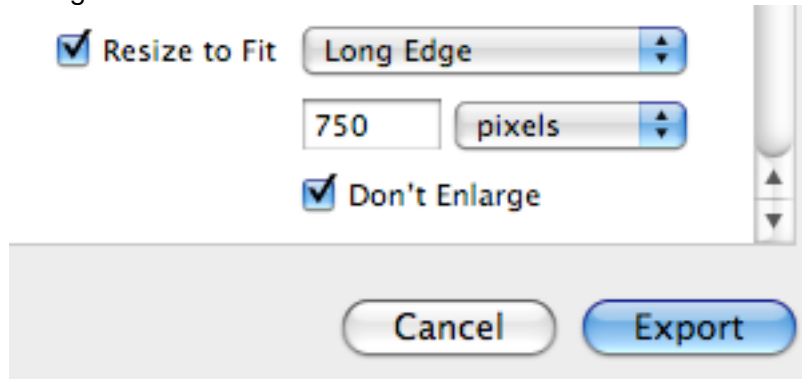
Step Four

Make sure you have selected the JPEG format and highest quality:



Step Five

Finally, in the resize dialog box make sure you have “Long Edge” selected in the drop-down menu and 750 in the box to the left of “pixels”. Then click on “Export”. Also, check the “Don’t Enlarge” box.



Step Six

This step is optional. You can create a “User Preset” that will enable you to preserve the proper settings for future export for HCC competitions. Click “Add” at the bottom of the left column and you will see the “New Preset” Dialog Box. Just name your preset (“HCC”) and click “Create”.
